### Lectionary Summary

Today's Readings: Amos 7:7–15 Ephesians 1:3–14 Mark 6:14–29

### ***The Lord Jesus Brings His People through Death into Life by the Preaching of Repentance***

Amos did not choose to be a prophet, but the Lord took him *“from following the flock”* and said to him, *“Go, prophesy to my people Israel”* (Amos 7:15). It was a hard word given him to preach: King Jeroboam would *“die by the sword,”* and Israel would *“go into exile away from his land”* (Amos 7:10–11). For this word, Amos was hated and threatened. St. John the Baptist also suffered for his faithful preaching of repentance. King Herod *“sent and seized John and bound him in prison,”* even though he knew that John *“was a righteous and holy man”* (Mark 6:17, 20). Out of pride and fear, Herod *“sent an executioner with orders to bring John’s head”* (Mark 6:27). Yet in Christ, St. John the Baptist *“has been raised from the dead”* (Mark 6:14, 16). For Christ is the destruction of death itself *“before the foundation of the world,”* and even now by faith, *“the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ”* has blessed us in Christ *“with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places”* (Eph. 1:3–4). Through Baptism into Christ, you also *“were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit”* for life and salvation (Eph. 1:13).



This is what [the Lord God] showed me: behold, the Lord was standing beside a wall built with a plumb line, with a plumb line in his hand. And the LORD said to me, "Amos, what do you see?" And I said, "A plumb line." Then the Lord said,

"Behold, I am setting a plumb line  
in the midst of my people Israel;

*Ephesians 1:3-14*

Working together with him, then, we appeal to you not to receive the grace of God in vain. For he says,

“In a favorable time I listened to you,  
and in a day of salvation I have helped you.”

Behold, now is the favorable time; behold, now is the day of salvation. ## Holy Gospel

**Mark 6: 14-29**

King Herod heard of it, for Jesus' name had become known. Some said, "John the Baptist has been raised from the dead. That is why these miraculous powers are at work in him." But others said, "He is Elijah." And others said, "He is a prophet, like one of the prophets of old." But when Herod heard of it, he said, "John, whom I beheaded, has been raised." For it was Herod who had sent and seized John and bound him in prison for the sake of Herodias, his brother Philip's wife, because he had married her. For John had been saying to Herod, "It is not lawful for you to have your brother's wife." And Herodias had a grudge against him and wanted to put him to death. But she could not, for Herod feared John, knowing that he was a righteous and holy man, and he kept him safe. When he heard him, he was greatly perplexed, and yet he heard him gladly.

But an opportunity came when Herod on his birthday gave a banquet for his nobles and military commanders and the leading men of Galilee. For when Herodias's daughter came in and danced, she pleased Herod and his guests. And the king said to the girl, "Ask me for whatever you wish, and I will give it to you." And he vowed to her, "Whatever you ask me, I will give you, up to half of my kingdom." And she went out and said to her mother, "For what should I ask?" And she said, "The head of John the Baptist." And she came in immediately with haste to the king and asked, saying, "I want you to give me at once the head of John the Baptist on a platter." And the king was exceedingly sorry, but because of his oaths and his guests he did not want to break his word to her. And immediately the king sent an executioner with orders to bring John's head. He went and beheaded him in the prison and brought his head on a platter and gave it to the girl, and the girl gave it to her mother. When his disciples heard of it, they came and took his body and laid it in a tomb.


